



AFL Riverina Umpire Social Media Policy

AUDIENCE AFL Riverina Umpires and AFL Riverina Umpire Coaching Group

AIMS To ensure all umpires respect each other and the football community through their use of social media

DETAILS

Social media is to be used for promoting umpiring as enjoyable and rewarding activity and to promote umpire achievements. All AFL Riverina Umpires and Umpire Coaches that use social media must not post damaging or inappropriate comments or photos on social media.

Umpires must not do any of the following on any social media site;

- Defame the AFL Riverina Board or staff, AFL Riverina Umpiring, any affiliated football league, football club or player on any social media site
- Share information that may be considered confidential information or intellectual property of AFL Riverina, AFL Riverina Umpiring or affiliated Football League or club
- Bring AFL Riverina, AFL Riverina Umpiring or any affiliated football league or club into disrepute
- Bully or harass any umpire or player within AFL Riverina or affiliated football leagues
- Make any comment that is obscene or inappropriate in the circumstances, this may include comments on other umpires, AFL Riverina, affiliated football clubs or players

Any umpire or umpire coach that posts unacceptable information on any site will be suspended from umpiring as determined by the AFL Riverina Umpire Coach Manager and AFL Riverina Umpire Coaches.
