Narrandera again showed glimpses of being able to match it with the competition's best in the 66-point loss to Turvey Park last weekend. They were held goalless in the first half but managed to kick seven second-half goals to add some respectability to the scoreline.

They will again have their work cut out for them this week against Coolamon, who appear to have found their mojo. Some last-quarter heroics from Bailey Wood helped the Hoppers to a thrilling win over Mangoplah-Cookardina United-Eastlakes, their third straight and one that catapulted them into third spot at the halfway mark of the season.

Tim Oosterhoff has begun to find his feet and is making an impact, while coach Jake Barrett returned last week and will only get better with every week.

The Rovers should not only continue on their winning way here but will look to find that ruthless edge and really begin to put sides away. Expect them to lap up the wide open surrounds of Narrandera Sportsground and post a big win here.

Could we be catching a sneak peak at the 2023 grand final when the ladder leaders host the reigning premiers at Maher Oval to kick off the second half of the year?

Turvey Park have hardly put a foot wrong to begin the year, cruising to seven wins from eight games to be six points clear atop of the ladder. Their only loss came against Ganmain-Grong Grong-Matong in the form of a 23-point defeat. Rhys Pollack has been the buy they hoped he would be and is arguably the best player in the competition right now. Add in exciting young talent like Kahlan Spencer, Patrick Payne, Oliver Bartter and Nick Conlan and it's a mix that oozes potential. There is certainly no reliance on the older players to have to get the job done.

Leeton-Whitton had a tough day at the office in their 80-point loss to Collingullie-Glenfield Park and to make matters worse look to have lost the experienced Matt Rainbird to suspension.

The western derby always creates plenty of interest over in the MIA but expect Griffith to continue their recent dominance here.

MCUE were again edged out in a close one last week, going down to Coolamon by four points at Kindra Park. The Goannas have won four, had a draw, and lost two of their three games by four-point margins and suddenly find themselves out of the top five. It can be a tough game at times.

'I am Woman, hear me roar'



LADIES Day is done a little differently at Wagga Tigers.

Yes, there is still plenty of bubbly, fine food and good times.

But it is all about making a difference.

Tigers will host their 12th edition of Ladies Day at Robertson Oval on Saturday when they welcome Mangoplah-Cookardinia United-Eastlakes.

The concept was created by Allison Schirmer and Kathy Flanigan 12 years ago as a charity fundraiser where the focus isn't as much about raising funds as it is about creating awareness and bringing people together.

"Kath and I both started organising Ladies Day together around 12 years ago," Schirmer explained.

"Our original theme was for breast cancer as a number of people in our club were affected or had family members, including myself, that were affected. We wanted to create awareness, raise funds, have fun, connect and celebrate together as women supporters of Tigers Football Club and bring all the ladies of the club past and present together.

"Ladies Day is about connection, awareness, and women in our club and the community and having some fun with drinks and some good food."

The day originally for Schirmer, a breast cancer survivor, was a way of moving forward.

"I don't know, I had just finished chemo the year before and I guess you're just trying to move forward, you're just trying to think forward," she said.

"I started playing netball again with the girls and it was more about that connection for me back in the club, feeling positive about myself.

"I guess it just keeps evolving over the years...and it's something we're always proud of each year."

The original theme of Wagga Tigers' Ladies Day was breast cancer. It gradually turned its attention to other cancers affecting women, before going onto mental health, motor neurone disease (MND) and a fundraiser for BrAshA-T in support of Jeff and Carly Miller's children, Charlie and Zara.

"Only recently they even turned their focus to celebrating the club's netball history and raised funds for a club netball honour board.

"Originally we were creating awareness for breast cancer. After a couple of years we decided to change our theme and focus on other charities. Women's cancers, then we decided other than cancer we needed to create awareness for other issues that affected people in our club and community like mental health...and MND," Schirmer said.

"And then speaking to Rob Gunsser one day. He has always been a supporter of the day and he was telling us about his two grandchildren (Charlie and Zara) with BrAshA-T and it was just heartbreaking to listen to so we just sort of went 'that's it, that's what we're going to do this year'.

"There's nothing we can do, it's just your way of supporting them. We're just giving them some sort of support, like any people that go through any life changing event. You're helpless to a certain degree so we just wanted to show our support."

After establishing one of the most important days on Wagga Tigers' calendar, Schirmer and Flanigan have 'retired' and this year passed the baton onto Kellie Irvine, Brooke Tilyard and a band of supporters.

This year's edition will raise funds and awareness for Carevan Wagga, a non-for-profit local charity for local people, that relied solely on donations to try and address the levels of homelessness, disadvantage, social isolation and food insecurity in our community.

"It's something both Kath and I are very passionate about," Schirmer said of Tigers' Ladies Day.

"We're pretty proud because it's just evolved from a simple ladies day, bring a plate, simple directions to over the years, we've created something that's become something everyone really looks forward to on the social calendar.

"Obviously there's lots of people helping and supporting us, it's not only Kath and I, and there's businesses as well that have supported us. Myer have been our number one supporter. Priceline, Big W, Riverina Home Centre, Renovator's Warehouse, Kristopher Graydon Jewellers, Pure PT Wagga, Simple Yoga. We've just been really fortunate with people that give us donations for prizes."

And as for the instructions as to those they are entrusting the day with for the future?

"Pretty much the brief is, raise awareness, find a charity, pick a theme and how you want to present it. There's no right or wrong with this. It's just about everyone coming together," Schirmer said.

"Especially with the young ones in the community, it's showing them about putting back into the community. The mental health awareness, all that sort of stuff. Just letting them know that there is support and there are people there. And for us mixing with them, especially the younger girls, having that occasion where we all come together as a club, which is really lovely.

"It's not just about drinking but having fun, supporting each other and raising awareness about issues that are affecting people in our club and wider community.

"Our intent is reflecting the people in our community that are having a tough time and letting them know we are here, we are here to offer support and raise some money for great causes while having a glass, nice food, great company and reconnecting."
