AFL Towards Zero Road Safety Round Returns

AFL Towards Zero Road Safety Round returns Following a successful round last year, local football and netball players will return to the field with an important road safety message for their peers. Transport for NSW and AFL NSW/ACT are teaming up again for the Towards Zero **Road Safety Round on Saturday 5 and Sunday 6 August**. Sally Webb, Deputy Secretary of Safety, Environment and Regulation at Transport for NSW said the football competition encourages everyone to prioritise road safety. "Players are wearing Towards Zero socks this round to serve as a reminder that crashes can be prevented and lives can be saved by making safe choices," Ms Webb said. "This round's aim is to encourage players, friends, family and the community to think about the choices they make on the roads and to know following the rules can prevent crashes and save lives. "We want everyone to drive in a way that ensures they, the people they love, and others on the road get home safely." Community Football and Competition manager Casey White said this is the second year the round has run. "The round will be played across southern NSW in the Riverina, Farrer, South Coast and Sapphire Coast," Mr White said. "It's an opportunity to remind all players that just like with sport, when it comes to driving it doesn't matter how skilled or experienced you are, or how familiar you are with a game plan or the road you drive every day, it's hard to know what's around the corner or to anticipate what another road user will do. "The three biggest killers on NSW roads are speed, drink driving and fatigue. Please drive responsibly for the safety of yourself and others. Drive below the speed limit OFFICIAL and consider road and weather conditions. Be well rested before getting behind the wheel, and if you're drinking, don't drive. Have a plan B to get back home safely."

Just as Griffith looked to be in the box seat for the minor premiership, they've been rolled at their past two outings and dropped to fourth spot. They haven't been blown away in their past two but haven't measured up to the likes of Ganmain-Grong Grong-Matong and Coolamon.

They get a good opportunity to bounce back here when they take on the winless Narrandera. The Eagles were well-beaten last week, going down by 74 points to Mangoplah-Cookardinia United-Eastlakes.

Narrandera were better after half-time but just haven't been able to match it with the top teams this season. Luke McKay continued his fine season with another strong display last week, while Jack Powell and Harvey Odgers have also tried hard.

Griffith now have a fight on their hands if they want to finish top three so expect them to get back to winning form here.

Turvey Park Bulldogs v Leeton-Whitton Crows

Turvey Park showed they are back to their best with an impressive 46-point win over Collingullie-Glenfield Park on Saturday.

After three losses in a row, Turvey Park are now back in the box seat for the minor premiership with back-to-back wins over Mangoplah-Cookardinia United-Eastlakes and Collingullie-Glenfield Park. 'Demons always striving to get better'



ANYONE that has been to Crossroads Oval this season would have noticed it looking a million dollars.

And that's been no mistake given the amount of work that has gone into transforming the home of Collingullie-Glenfield Park Demons.

Over \$1 million has been put into the facility over the last four or five years.

It began with the construction of brand new clubrooms and continued this year with the unveiling of their two new netball courts, complete with a shelter over one.

Collingullie-Glenfield Park Football Netball Club president Noel Penfold is proud of the work that has been done to the Crossroads Oval facility.

"We've done the netball courts, clubrooms, and cladded the old clubrooms," Penfold said.

"It would be over \$1 million that we've spent and a lot of it would have come out of the community.

"We got grants for it but a lot of money was raised out of the community. Supporters would have chipped in a quarter of that, or more.

"With our clubrooms, our supporters chipped in \$130,000 and that was without anything in kind."

The improvements to Crossroads Oval were all part of the club's plan to improve on and off the field.

"It was a decision made by the club, we had to get better," Penfold said.

"We had to improve our facilities. You attract people to your club by having good facilities.

"We've got a really good culture going, a good mob of people, there's a lot of good stuff happening around the club. We've got a really good, stable committee.

"There's a few things happening, which is exciting."

The Demons have been a force of the Riverina League since their promotion from the Farrer League in 2011.

They won their first Riverina League premiership in 2014 and followed it up with further first grade flags in 2015 and 2018.

They now believe they have the facilities to match their on-field prowess and strong culture.

"We're getting a lot of people around, we're getting a lot of supporters to games, we get a lot of supporters to training, you go up there Thursday night and there can be 20 or 30 supporters sitting around watching," Penfold explained.

"Things are rolling pretty good at the 'Gullie."

With Crossroads Oval looking the goods, Collingullie-Glenfield Park's junior club is now taking advantage of the facility and taking some home games out there.

Penfold said the club's focus was now firmly on the juniors.

"We're playing some juniors out at our home ground now and everyone seems to love it," he said.

"We are massively working on improving our juniors. That's a key focus.

"Our juniors have slipped a bit and we're putting a lot of effort into improving our juniors."

Club junior Nick Perryman, alongside Brett Somerville, led Collingullie-Glenfield Park to the Riverina League grand final last year, but went down to Ganmain-Grong Grong-Matong.

Perryman has taken the reins solo this year and after a slow start, has the team firing and right in the hunt for finals.

The Demons are already planning for the future and will announce their new coaching line-up for 2024 very soon.

"We'll have our 15s coaches, our 17s coaches, our reserve grade coaches and hopefully our first grade coaches able to be announced," Penfold said.

And as like anything at Collingullie, the decisions that have been made are all with the focus of getting better.

"It's not that we're not competitive this year, we just want to be that bit better," Penfold said.
