Second Semi-Final

Turvey Park Bulldogs v Griffith Swans

It's been a long time coming but Turvey Park are back within one win of their first grand final appearance since 2010.

The Bulldogs achieved their first minor premiership in more than 20 years and they now go in fresh and ready to go against Griffith in the second semi-final.

The Swans could hardly have been more impressive last week when accounting for Ganmain-Grong Grong-Matong by 15 points in the qualifying final. It was fast, end-to-end football and Griffith's group stood tall when it mattered. Jack Rowston's ball use from half-back was divine, while the run of Taine Moraschi and the Spencer boys complemented the work of Rhys Pollock, Sam Foley and Alex Page perfectly. The tall targets of Henry Delves and James Toscan also proved pivotal.

Turvey Park will look to bring a similar style to their finals campaign. They will look to their youth to make the most of their running game in the wide open spaces of Narrandera Sportsground. The loss of mid-season returnee Will O'Connor is a blow to the Bulldogs but they do have plenty of depth. Turvey Park have strong leadership from the likes of Tim Doyle, Cal Dooley and Antony Forato, but it's the likes of Luke Fellows, Jack Glanvill, Luke Mazzocchi and Rhett Weidemann that could really tear finals apart.

The battle between Nathan Richards and Forato in the ruck shapes as a telling one, as both look to give their respective midfields first use. Both defensive groups will also have big tasks. The Lions struggled to find someone to contain Henry Delves last week. Brad Ashcroft is the spearhead for Turvey Park and he has taken some stopping this year.

Both teams have enjoyed a win apiece against each other this year, winning their respective home games. Turvey Park prevailed by three points first, before Griffith returned serve with a 13-point win later in the year so it shapes as a cracker. Both clubs are looking to end decent-sized premiership droughts with their last flags coming in successive years of 2002-03 so the prospect of qualifying straight through to the decider is an attractive one.

Prediction: Griffith by 5 points

First Semi-Final

Ganmain-Grong Grong-Matong Lions v Collingullie-Glenfield Park Demons

The reigning premiers will look to use their double chance earlier than what they hoped for when they take on Collingullie-Glenfield Park in a replay of last year's grand final at Narrandera on Sunday. The Lions were on the wrong-end of a high-quality affair against Griffith on Saturday, while the Demons got home in a scrappy yet thrilling battle with Coolamon.

Ganmain-Grong Grong-Matong will take confidence from the fact they've won both games against the Demons this year. They prevailed in a shoot-out by 27 points earlier in the year before going to Collingullie and getting the job done by five points in the second half of the season.

Lions coach Sam Martyn was in superb touch across half-back last week and did everything he could to get his team over the line. Which end of the ground Ben Walsh is most suited at, or where the team most needs him, would be a source of much debate at selection. He continues to do a good job up forward and kicked a couple of important goals but is certainly missed in defence. The warmer weather and high intensity of finals looked to bring a couple of Lions players undone last week but they'll be better for the run and looking for improved performances this week.

The Demons might have been a little lucky to escape with a four-point win last week but they live to tell the tale. Coolamon had a number of chances to ice the game but failed to do so, but the Demons did squander a number of opportunities also. It was good to see Steve Jolliffe up and about on the big stage. He can be a real weapon for the Demons through the finals series in that kind of form. Kane Flack continues to show his worth in the Riverina League, while defenders Harry Radley and James Pope again stood up on the finals stage.

The loss to Griffith was GGGM's first defeat since June 24, while Collingullie have won eight out of their last 10 so both teams are in good form. With the evenness of the competition, whoever wins this will back themselves to go all the way.

Mangoplah-Cookardinia United-Eastlakes Goannas v Coolamon Rovers

Coolamon will have the task in front of them when they take on the all-conquering Mangoplah-Cookardinia United-Eastlakes indoors at Narrandera Sportsground Stadium on Saturday. The Goannas have been far and away the form team of this year's competition. They've won 14 straight heading into this week's finals, with their one and only loss coming by just a single goal to Griffith in round one.

Finals netball under the roof at Narrandera can often be a completely different ball game but the Goannas have been there and done it all before so it's hard to see too many chinks in their armour. They took on Coolamon in the final round of the season and came out 12-goal victors.

Coolamon haven't had a great deal of finals experience in recent times but have brought across a number of players from the Farrer League that do know what it takes. The Rovers will take confidence from a 12-goal win over Griffith in last week's qualifying final at Narrandera.

There is no doubt MCUE are favourites to take out this year's title but this game should give us a good indication of how far off Coolamon is.

Griffith will take confidence from the fact they've beaten Collingullie-Glenfield Park on both occasions this year. They won by eight goals in Griffith in round eight, then smashed the Demons by 21 on their home court just before finals.

The Demons were impressive in their 14-goal win over Wagga Tigers in the elimination final. However Griffith shape as much more formidable opponents and Collingullie will have to produce their best netball of the season to keep their year alive here.

'Leaving the bulldogs in good shape'



CONFIDENCE in knowing Turvey Park are in a really strong position for the future made the decision to finish up as coach of the Bulldogs an easier one for Michael Mazzocchi.

Reigning best and fairest winner Cal Dooley will coach Turvey Park in 2024 after Mazzocchi made the decision to step down at season's end following three years at the helm.

Walking away from something you love is always difficult to do but even more so when that something is the Bulldogs, and they've continued their rise to a minor premiership and are now just one win away from their first grand final appearance in 13 years. Mazzocchi concedes it wasn't an easy decision but is comfortable with the fact he believes three years of his style is enough for one group.

"Because I love it so much and I wasn't a Turvey person until I started coaching, but once you get involved in it, it's like every footy club in the country, there's such great people involved, then you become a real part of it," Mazzocchi said.

"Especially the success side, when you start winning games. The year I took over, they'd won one game the year before. To see us go to win a final last year and also this year, you win a minor premiership but there's no guarantees in footy, there's no guarantees that we're going to make the last day in the RFL decider.

"That was the thing that Turvey said when they were trying to keep me, what if we don't win it this year, would you go again and try to win it next year. For me, it was more to take a step back.

"I've had three years, I'm quite demanding on the playing group in that I really do expect everyone to train and train hard and I think your success comes off the back of your preparation and training.

"So I just felt they would be ready for a new voice next year and the four years, it could have possibly worked, but it also could backfire." Enter the transition plan.

"I felt like we had a really good coach in waiting in Cal, he's a really good on-field leader, a good person off the field and got a good football brain so I thought when we've got someone there who is a good coach in waiting, why don't we do the transition while I'm still around," Mazzocchi said.

"I'll still be around Turvey, Luke's re-signed there so I'll still be around so I'll be able to help mentor and guide Cal in that first year.

"So it was a tough decision and I know the club would have loved me to take it on and go again but I think when we look back in 12 months time we'll say it was a really good decision."

Mazzocchi is confident Dooley is the right man to carry the club forward.

The experienced footballer and coach has been around long enough to know and he believes with some success and the right management going forward, Turvey Park can be the next powerhouse of the competition.

"I've always said with the age demographic at Turvey where everyone's in that low 20s, high teens, if we can get to the top, Turvey Park can realistically stay there for a number of years if it's managed well," he said.

"Success breeds success so if we can just get some success, these young kids coming through the 17s they expect success and we can really Turvey into a powerhouse if we manage it properly."

Ahead of their second semi-final showdown with Griffith at Narrandera Sportsground on Saturday, Mazzocchi said the excitement around Maher Oval makes Turvey Park a great place to be.

"It is, it's really good, even winning the minor premiership, although I down played it as a coach, you could just see what it meant to the committee," he said.

"We went back to The Rules Club that night to do our awards and they were really excited and they made a big deal of it. They haven't won a minor premiership in 20-odd, 30 years and it meant so much to them to have a first grade side that is performing.

"Not only first grade, second grade finished the season second on the ladder, the 17s were fourth on the ladder so every footy team is playing finals and we had three grades in netball.

"There is just a really good feeling. Just to go back to The Rules Club for our awards, we're getting 100, 150 people back there. There's a lot of good club people that are really enjoying the success that we've had so far this year."

Mazzocchi knows getting over Griffith on Saturday is no easy task. The two teams have both enjoyed one win apiece over the other and the Swans come into it on the back of an impressive win over reigning premiers Ganmain-Grong Grong-Matong in last week's qualifying final.

"They've probably followed a similar pattern to us. We had a little off period there mid-season, through whatever reasons, we lost three in a row, and Griffith look like they went through a similar thing later in the season," Mazzocchi said.

"You need luck and injuries play a big part in things and to keep your players motivated through such a long year because you've got to remember we started training, we did a little bit pre-Christmas and then you kick off the first week in January so we're basically nine months in now, it's such a long year so keeping that motivation up.

"Both the games we've played have been really, really highly-skilled, fast, good games of footy to watch. Both of us possess those young, fit guys and the good big ruckman, the solid backmen and the good key forwards so we're very similar and we match up pretty similar on each other and the results both times, one for us, one for them, and both were single-digit results or pretty close.

"I remember the day at Maher Oval where we were able to beat them, we got out to a five or six-goal lead at one point and their ability to score so quickly and heavily got them back in it so that will definitely be one thing we're trying to focus on is to stop that momentum if they happen to get it.

"Momentum in footy is such a big thing and if you let the opposition kick three, four, five, six in a row, you're in a lot of trouble.

"We'll definitely be going in with a lot of respect for Griffith."

Marrar Bombers v Northern Jets

The Bombers will get a second chance at qualifying for another grand final when they take on the Jets at Robertson Oval on Sunday. Marrar were outclassed by The Rock-Yerong Creek in the second semi-final, with the final margin of 32 points flattering them.

Marrar were shown up in the midfield against the Magpies and will need to be much better there given the quality that Northern Jets boast through there. The Jets' guns all enter the final in good form too after a 76-point annihilation of Charles Sturt University in the first semi-final at Langtry Oval last Sunday.

The obvious concern for the Jets comes on the injury front. After a relatively good run throughout the year, they now face the prospect of being without assistant coach Sam Fisher and star full-forward Matt Wallis for the biggest game of their season so far. Fisher is in doubt with a hamstring injury, while Wallis picked up an elbow issue, which were both sustained in the win over the Bushpigs.

Bryce Mann, Harry Reynolds and Jordan Hedington have all been in good touch off half-back, while Blake Walker looms as their match-winner in attack.

The Jets had all their guns firing last weekend. Mitch Hadrill was back at his best, Jack Fisher got the party started with a lively four-goal effort up forward and Adam Flagg showed what he can add to their forward line.

The teams met at the same venue a fortnight ago and it resulted in a 14-point Marrar win. The Bombers played closed to their best that day, and the Jets wasted a number of opportunities in front of goal. If the Jets can produce anywhere near their best, and take their chances this time around, they are a massive chance of playing in their first grand final since 2007.
