Overview	The internship is a 22-week (minimum) program based in Wagga that will introduce you to broadcast and media coverage for AFL Riverina matches.
Position Outline	 Film top level AFL Riverina matches and assist with media coverage on a weekly basis. Tasks include: Film football matches at a quality that can be used for video analysis for players and officials Film post-match interviews after each game (interviews will be conducted by club volunteers) Edit matches in a timely manner Upload and cataloguing of footage to an online database
Contact hours	Minimum 6 hrs a week (one day per weekend, which an honorarium would be offered) Interns are required to be available on Saturdays during the 2018 AFL Riverina Season
