



## **AFL Riverina Umpire Injury Policy and Procedure**

All AFL Riverina registered umpires are covered for Non-medicare medical under the JLT Australian Football National Risk Protection Program for any injury sustained while umpiring an official match where appointed by the AFL Riverina Umpire Department or when attending an official AFL Riverina umpire training session. Umpires must follow the below procedure to make a claim:

## **PROCEDURE**

- You must complete the <u>AFL Riverina Injury Report Form</u> as soon as possible after the injury has occurred. Once completed, a copy will be sent to the umpire for their records and the AFL Riverina Umpire Coach Manager.
- Umpire to then complete <u>JLT Personal Injury Claim</u> where there will be claim for non-medicare medical expenses

Note: no umpire will be appointed to a game while a claim is in progress and until the umpire has been cleared to return to umpiring duties

Umpires who are injured but do not wish to follow the above procedure, must accept responsibility for their own medical treatment and expenses.
