# 'Students stepping up on and off the field



WHEN Sarah Trewick was separated from her loved ones for the best part of two years during the COVID pandemic, it was the Charles Sturt University Football Netball Club that proved to be a family away from her family.

Hailing from Elmore in central Victoria, Trewick is similar to many of those at the Bushpigs and 'Sows that have moved to Wagga purely for university studies.

Trewick made the move to on-campus life at CSU in 2020, not long before COVID hit. She was sent home to Elmore for four weeks initially, but then was back at uni and locked out of her home state for four months.

She was secretary at CSU last year, before taking on the umpire coordinator position this year as she juggles that with her fourth and final year of a bachelor of education.

Trewick finds CSU a unique club.

"The club is very much a volunteer club, we're not really a family club but it still feels like one," she said.

"So I came from a club back home that was all family, my dad was the president, my nanna had pretty much ran the netball side and I've always pretty much been in that committee sense, helping out around the club and that sort of stuff.

"The way that the club welcomed me into it, I found that very comfortable and very easy to step up and help out.

"We're very much a volunteer-based club in that if you don't step up, it doesn't happen because no one's really there to pick up the slack

Gab Goldsworthy, at 25, feels like an old head at CSU given she first arrived back in 2017 from Beechworth.

With a passion for women's football, Goldsworthy loves the fact the club's destiny is in their own hands.

"I guess that's the other cool thing about our club is that it's all run by us. If we want to make something happen, it's on us and we get in and get it done," Goldsworthy said.

"That gives us a bit more ownership, and pride and direction as to what we want to happen and see in terms of club culture and events.

"When I first moved here I was pretty big on girls footy and Rocket (Michael Irons) was like, prove to me you can get a team up and running and we'll think about it. It was pretty much, if you want to do it, do it. Get some support, show us it can happen and we'll support you.

"Everyone's just so good to be around, really. Lots of variations as to where people have come from, lots of different backgrounds and stories so that's nice."

Max Findlay, at 20, is already a best and fairest winner and has just entered his third season at CSU.

Studying a bachelor of agricultural science, Findlay made his senior debut as a teenager at Barellan despite hailing from a rugby league background.


