Collingullie-Glenfield Park Demons v Coolamon Rovers

One coach is going to leave Crossroads Oval on Saturday a relieved man, while headaches await the loser.

These two teams were tipped to be fighting it out for the flag at the start of the year but both find themselves with their backs square against the wall heading into round six. Coolamon are yet to fire a shot this season, winning their two games against Leeton-Whitton and Narrandera, but have stumbled against Turvey Park and Wagga Tigers. The Rovers have a huge month ahead and could be out of the race completely if they don't pull things together.

The injury to coach Jake Barrett certainly hasn't helped and it's been well-documented with their problems in the ruck. The Chase Grintell plan only lasted two weeks and now it looks as though Anthony Atkin will return from Newcastle on several occasions to try and solve Coolamon's ruck problem.

Collingullie aren't going well either. They started the year with a trashing of Narrandera but has since slumped to three consecutive losses, going down to Turvey Park, Mangoplah-Cookardinia United-Eastlakes and Ganmain-Grong Grong-Matong.

The Demons showed better signs in last week's loss to GGGM but need to get back to winning form quickly before the season slips away. Hopefully Matt Klemke can get back on the paddock shortly as he looms as an important part of their midfield.

A big game with high stakes.

'Premiership party to hit Coleambally'



SOME of the greatest players in Coleambally's proud history will return to the club on Saturday for one hell of a premiership party.

The Blues will recognise some of the club's best ever teams when they hold not one but four premiership reunions at Coleambally.

The 1988 and 1993 first grade premiership teams will regather, while the grand final-winning reserve grade teams of 1998 and 2003 will also come together.

It has been almost 30 years since Robbie Owen led Coleambally to the 1993 Coreen League premiership.

The Blues capped off a fine season with a dominant finals series, defeating Rand in the grand final 19.11 (125) to 11.7 (73) at Buraja.

When Owen arrived at Coleambally from Griffith at the start of 1992, he recognised the talent was there but had to find tune some rough edges to their game.

"I was very, very lucky to coach such a good footy team, I know that," Owen said.

"I coached them for two years, I was pretty tough, because they had a lot of talent but were a little bit undisciplined so I was pretty rugged on them and in the end from the backline to the forward line they were terrific.

"In my experience in footy, fairytales don't happen very, very often, if you win it, you win it because you're the best side, not that I ever told them that, but they were the best side for sure."

The Coleambally team of 1993 featured a core group of talented locals with a sprinkle of outside polish in the form of some Griffith recruits.

The year before Coleambally had been bundled out in the preliminary final by Rand but wouldn't have quite been good enough to beat eventual premiers, Rennie.

A couple of significant things happened over the off-season.

"They woke up," Owen recalls.

"They realised they needed to be more disciplined about everything. I designed a game for them and said this is the way we should play."

The other was the arrival of Rob Harrington, who came out of retirement and would go on to win the league goalkicking with 68 goals for the year.

"Rob was a big strong player, if he didn't mark it, the ball came to ground," Owen said.

"Ricky Miller, he was pretty heavily tagged in 1992, he was on a half forward flank and a very good goalkicker but when you've only got that one avenue to goal, you can be easy to stop.

"So once we got Harro there, Ricky was only three or four goals behind him for the season as well. We had a two-pronged attack and once you get two avenues to goal like that, well then they can't cover everyone and then blokes pop up everywhere. We kicked a lot of high scores but that's how."

Owen, who battled injury throughout the 1993 season, finished up at Coleambally after the premiership success. He now resides at Wantabadgery and doesn't get to much local footy these days.

He has nothing but fond memories of his time at Coleambally and is looking forward to catching up.

"Everything about Coleambally was great back then, it really was. The town got right behind us. You win a premiership that's what you play footy for, with your mates, so it was a pretty special time," he said.

"The fellas out there, they were great blokes, they really were. It was all about them.

"A bloke said to me down the track that Mickey Mouse could have coached that side in the end and I said yeah he probably could have. It was a credit to them.

"They put up with me, I was pretty rugged with them early on, but they were a terrific bunch of blokes and they played so well and hard for each other.

"That's what I used to love about them, because I was injured and watched a lot in that second year and they were just so relentless, they would run in numbers and would tackle, tackle and tackle and eventually opposition would turn the ball over and boom, away they'd go.

"They were a special group of blokes, no doubt about it."

The premiership reunion will coincide with Coleambally's home game against ladder leaders The Rock-Yerong Creek on Saturday.




