Wagga Tigers v Griffith Swans

Another big game in the Riverina League where second hosts fourth. Both teams are guaranteed a spot in the top five at the halfway mark of the season but the winner will entrench themselves in the top three.

Tigers have won five in a row to make a strong case they will be fighting it out for another flag at season's end. Their task in the short-term has been made more difficult with the loss of captain-coach Murray Stephenson for at least a month with a hamstring injury. If Ben Kelly is also added to the list of outs, they will be missing their two most important key position players.

Tigers have been boosted by the full-time return of Jackson Kelly, while the likes of Jock Cornell, Jesse Manton and Jeremy Piercy continue to play good footy.

Griffith returned to form with a 72-point thrashing of Collingullie with young guns Kahlan Spencer, Nick Conlan and Taine Moraschi leading the way. The Swans have shown their best is good enough but have struggled somewhat with consistency, which they're not alone on given the competitiveness of this year's competition.

Tigers in-form and at home probably means they are entitled to go in as favourites but with a couple of key outs, Griffith are certainly capable of landing an upset.

Prediction: Wagga Tigers by 3 points

Turvey Park Bulldogs v Narrandera Eagles

Narrandera will carry some momentum into the trip to Maher Oval after giving a big sight in the three-goal loss to Wagga Tigers last time out. It showed when Narrandera are able to put it together they can challenge the top teams.

Turvey Park have enjoyed a double bye since their impressive 44-point win over Mangoplah-Cookardinia United-Eastlakes. There will be no Angus Curry this time after the star junior made a cameo appearance for the Bulldogs during a VFL bye.

Antony Forato continues to shine in the ruck, while Brad Ashcroft leads the league goalkicking. Everything is going well for the Bulldogs despite picking up some injuries along the way and they should complete a near-perfect first half of the year with a comfortable win at home.

Leeton-Whitton again showed some promising signs in their 31-point loss to Leeton-Whitton. Jade Hodge made another cameo and kicked three goals, while Tom Groves was very good leading from the front.

The way Collingullie are going, the Crows will fancy themselves a sneaky chance at Crossroads on Saturday, as it has been the scene of an upset or two between the teams in the past. It is a must-win for the Demons if they want to keep any chance of finals alive.

Coolamon are back! The pre-season favourites looked gone after a slow start to the season but have come to life with back-to-back wins against Griffith and Ganmain-Grong Grong-Matong.

The Rovers will look to keep that momentum going when they host Mangoplah-Cookardinia United-Eastlakes at home on Sunday. Key forward Tim Oosterhoff has really found form over the past couple of weeks with some commanding performances up forward. BJ Glyde and Allister Clarke have also played significant roles in Coolamon's turnaround.

The Rovers hope to get Hayden Bradley and Luke Gerhard back for the clash, while coach Jake Barrett isn't too far away either. 'North wagga to celebrate history on Saints Day'



A RELATIVELY new annual tradition is starting to gather momentum at North Wagga that celebrates the club's rich history.

North Wagga will hold 'Saints Day' at McPherson Oval on Saturday, August 5, when they play host to The Rock-Yerong Creek in their final home and away match for the year.

The concept started around premiership reunions and is in the midst of becoming an annual opportunity for all North Wagga players and supporters, past and present, to come together and catch up.

"We have what we call a Saints day every year now," North Wagga president Brendan Nielsen explained.

"What we do is we try to encompass what reunions there are for the year because what we found is that with individual reunions, people would say I didn't play in that so I'm not coming. We're trying to get everybody there.

"It's been going about three years. We had a really successful day last year with 92 and 91 reunions. The idea behind it is to not just get the players but everyone that was involved, all supporters, to come along and get together.

"We throw them a couple of beers and give them a steak sandwich during the day, we get the huddle right next to the club so they can go out and be a part of it. After the game, we'll give them 5-10 minutes each on the stage to talk about it.

"It's all about recognition basically."

At the centre of this year's Saints Day will be the premiership reunions of the 1973 and 1983 first grade teams. The 1993 and 2013 reserve grade premiership reunions will also be celebrated.

North Wagga 1973 premiership player Mick Landrigan has been tasked with organising the return of the team that defeated Henty in the grand final.

He is a big fan of the Saints Day concept and expects to get about 20 of the premiership team along for the 50-year anniversary of their drought-breaking premiership win.

"Most of the blokes are going to be over 70 so we're calling it more of a get together, it's like a reunion but might drag a few more blokes in if they know they're not committed to a sit down meal and have to do this and do that," Landrigan said.

"Just a day at the footy. Anyone can do what they like, they can come when they like, leave when they like. It's a better option for us older fellas."

Alan Hayes coached North Wagga to the 1973 premiership, the club's first grand final success in 38 years.

Landrigan has fond memories of his days at the Saints, in an era he believes is much better than today's football.

"It was a bloody good time," Landrigan said.

"North Wagga hadn't won a premiership for 38 years. The irony of it was our strapper at the times, Teddy Davis, he coached that team 38 years ago. He lived in North Wagga, he loved strapping, he was a real character.

"It's funny the things that used to happen in those days, because it was such a social event. You would play footy for the social side of it. It wouldn't matter if you'd win or lose in footy, it was after the game that you would look forward to. You get friends for life in footy."

Landrigan recalls two major factors in North Wagga's 1973 premiership success. One was their recruiting and the second was the discipline instilled in them by coach Hayes.

"They recruited well. They had a great president in Ned Fife and ex-players Phil Hamilton and Freddy McGregor. They just combined well together as a committee and said we'll go out and by ourselves a premiership. They recruited really well," he said.

"A bit of recruitment and a bit of a commitment from the coach. Hayesy came out in 72 I think and it was just a bit of discipline. Greg Hardie had coached North Wagga before that and he won three Baz Medals, he was a champion but they were good old social drinkers, North Wagga boys, in those days. And Haysey changed all that.

"He didn't stop anyone drinking but Thursday night was the last, that was it. Little things like that. Big games he would stress you've got to look after yourself and things like that changed a lot of players.

"It bucked the system at first but when they realised he was fair dinkum, we all banded together and stuck with him and got the premiership. We had some good years after it as well and that was the start of it.

"It was a great time to be in footy."

Landrigan is looking forward to recalling fond memories and stories, like the way premiership player Brian Fegan ended up at McPherson Oval.

"The funny thing, one of the best players we picked up was Brian Fegan," he recalled.

"He was standing outside the old college near the Showgrounds, waiting for Teddy Ryan from Wagga Tigers to pick him up. It was his first day to go to footy.

"Rex Burge drove past and seen him there standing with a bag. He pulled up and said what are you doing mate, he said I'm waiting for a ride to go to footy training and he said jump in.

"We jagged him. He played for NSW. Just things like that, that helped."

Hayes intends on making it down from Port Macquarie for Saints day. Landrigan also wants to ensure his assistant coach Rex Burge is also there on the day.

He says it's times like these, 'Saints Day', that you play football for.

"I'm really looking forward to it. I really didn't think I would be celebrating 50 years after playing in a grand final. That's something you dream about and now it's here. It's really good," he said.

"I hope we can talk to some of the players, especially the young players in a group. If we can get to talk to a few of the young blokes to try and inspire them. Just to really get into the social side and enjoy it.

"Hopefully we can get the club kicking again."


