The Crows will hopefully come into the clash refreshed and rejuvenated after the bye. The young Leeton group were looking for the bye with some disappointing performances heading into it after starting the year with a lot of promise.

The Goannas would be wishing their double bye never happened. They went into it undefeated and travelling well and have coughed up two disappointing losses in their two games since.

While they have had some talent sitting on the sidelines, that was no excuse against a fellow undermanned Turvey team last Saturday, that ran away with a 44-point win out at Mangoplah Sportsground. The Goannas will desperately want Ryan Turnbull and the Male brothers back. They will also be counting down the days to Sam de Sousa's arrival, while Dion Munkara's absence has been notable as well.

MCUE should return to winning form here but it will be more the performance that co-coaches Jeremy Rowe and Nelson Foley are worried about as they face a season-defining stretch after the long weekend bye.

Narrandera Eagles v Wagga Tigers

All eyes will be on Narrandera Sportsground on Saturday as 'Mummy' arrives in town.

Former Geelong, Sydney and GWS Giants star Shane Mumford will make a guest appearance for Narrandera and it will take a game footballer from Tigers to stand in the big man's way.

Mumford had a reputation as a giant wrecking ball in the AFL so it will be interesting to see what damage he does in his one-off appearance in the Riverina League. In all seriousness, he should provide the winless Narrandera team with a huge boost on the field, but also in confidence heading into the game. He will give them some much-needed size up forward and no doubt will also spend time in the ruck.

Two teams looking to find some form and bounce back will go head-to-head at Exies Oval on Saturday.

A fortnight ago, you could have made a strong case that Griffith were shaping as the team to beat this season but have since crashed to consecutive defeats against Turvey Park and Coolamon. The Swans lost few admirers in a close loss to the Bulldogs, but were disappointing at home last Sunday when going down by 33 points to a previously out-of-form Coolamon team.

There weren't too many excuses for Griffith last Sunday but they should get James Toscan back for the Demons clash. They will be looking for big performances from the likes of Rhys Pollack, Jack Rowston, Nathan Richards and Henry Delves to try and get their season back on track.

Last year's grand finalists, Collingullie, have never really been on track this season. They only have the one scalp, in Coolamon, but did show good enough signs in an 11-point loss to Wagga Tigers last Saturday. Still, they need a win here otherwise they will quickly lose touch with the top five.

Kane Flack has been in good touch since his arrival but coach Nick Perryman would be wanting more from the likes of Steve Jolliffe, Harry Radley, James Pope and Sam Stening as they look to rediscover the form of last season.

'Narrandera abuzz ahead of 'Mummys' arrival in town'



IT WAS over breakfast at a Sydney cafe back in January when Graham Flynn put to Shane Mumford the idea about a guest appearance at Narrandera.

The recently-retired AFL star has a close relationship with Matt Flynn and it was the young Narrandera product that set up the meeting between his dad and Mumford.

Graham Flynn wanted to generate some excitement at Narrandera for the upcoming season and was pleasantly surprised by Mumford's response.

"He was really good. He was great to speak to," Flynn said.

"The thing about him is it's about the kids. He's got kids of his own. I was driving the point that Narrandera has been struggling but we've got a lot of kids and what I was trying to do was to get someone there or something there to get a spark to keep the kids interested for the future.

"He was great about that. That's what he's about."

So Flynn will pick up the 216-game retired AFL star from the airport on Friday afternoon. He will get straight to work with the club's Auskick kids that night, helping out at training before answering some questions and signing autographs.

On Saturday, he will help with Narrandera's juniors, before going to breakfast with the senior team. It will be then into the big game against Wagga Tigers, before being put under the grill by MC Cooper Irons at a sportsman's night afterwards.

Flynn will then get him to the airport first thing Sunday, where Mumford will fly back to Sydney for his game-day duties with the Giants in their clash against Richmond.

"He's not just coming down for a game. It's great that he's playing but I see it more as coming down to promote the game and get the interest going in the town. That's what I see it as," Flynn said.

"I said I don't care if you stand at full-forward all day and he said no, I'm going to have to go in the centre at some stage. He's played one, maybe two games already this year in Sydney so he'll come down with the right attitude and I'm sure it will be great for the club.

"Narrandera has struggled for a few years but if we can just promote the club and it leads to something in future that would be great but it's about keeping the kids involved."

Experienced Narrandera coach Shaun Brooker said there was already plenty of excitement among the playing group about Mumford's impending arrival.

"Absolutely. I'm probably going to get a bit of feedback on my coaching from him as well, but also our young fellas, getting to play with someone who has only been out of the system a couple of years playing and he's still in the system coaching so our fellas, they're just champing at the bit to play with him," Brooker said.

"From all reports, he's been training for this game and preparing himself to give himself the best opportunity to have a good day as well. It just shows that he's invested too.

"I think it's a great thing for country footy that we can do these sorts of things, particularly in our league, I think it will be great."

Mumford is only 36 and retired at the end of the 2021 season after a stellar career at Geelong, Sydney and Greater Western Sydney (GWS).

He was a premiership player at Sydney in 2012 and won the Kevin Sheedy Medal for best-and-fairest at the Giants in his first year at the club in 2014.

Mumford remains involved at the Giants to this day as a part-time ruck coach.

Mumford stood at 199cm during his playing days but was always well over 100 kilograms, which says a lot about the physicality he brought to his game.

With Narrandera boasting a talented young ruckman in Brad Hutchison, Mumford is likely to spend time forward, as well as the ruck.

"I think so. That was his go-to positions in the AFL, ruck and forward," Brooker said.

"Talking about developing guys, it will be great for Brad Hutchison to ruck with Mummy and get a few tips from him, and our midfielders, so it's a win-win for everyone."

Narrandera go into Saturday's game winless after their opening six games but Brooker is confident there are plenty of positive signs there, as shown in last weekend's 41-point loss to defending premiers Ganmain-Grong Grong-Matong.

"We're ticking a lot of boxes but just dropping away in quarters and starts to games with having such a young list," he said.

"But in saying that, some of our ball movement and structures have been really, really good this year. On the weekend, we let ourselves down in a few areas. We probably could have kept it a lot closer to Ganmain but just some turnovers, a bit of inexperience, let us down a little bit."

Brooker is confident the Eagles are on the right path with their group.

"Yeah we are. The boys are invested," he said.

"Just watching on the weekend, Shannon Randell got injured in the second quarter and he was pointing things out on the bench, we're doing this, we are getting better, we're doing that.

"We've got a pretty tight-knit group so we are getting better."


