

Ganmain-Grong Grong-Matong Lions v Leeton-Whitton Crows

Ganmain-Grong Grong-Matong returned to the top five with a six-goal win over Wagga Tigers last Sunday to move into fourth spot. With the stakes high it was the Lions' leaders that led from the front with Sam Martyn, Ben Walsh, Matt Hamblin and Jacob Olsson all having a big influence on the result.

Olsson kicked six goals from deep in attack and his match up will be one causing Leeton-Whitton coach Tom Groves a few headaches this week.

The Crows themselves will come in with confidence after bringing up their second win of the year last weekend with a 43-point win over Narrandera. It was quite emphatic in the end as Leeton-Whitton piled on 14 goals to three from quarter time onwards.

Jade Hodge was back at it, returning to kick five goals in another performance that suggests he's still got something to give the Crows at first grade level. Tom Meline and Angus Crelley also had strong performances.

The Crows gave a good sight for three quarters against the Lions earlier in the year and there's no reason why they can't do the same again on the back of last week's effort.

Prediction: GGGM by 50 points

Mangoplah-Cookardinia United-Eastlakes Goannas v Griffith Swans

The topsy-turvy season of Mangoplah-Cookardinia United-Eastlakes continued last weekend when they offered up a disappointing performance at home against Collingullie-Glenfield Park on a day the club celebrated the 30-year reunion of their last premiership.

The final margin finished up at 20 points but it was much worse than that for most of the day and flattered the Goannas. The issue appears to be the massive gap between their best and worst, and the lack of consistency.

Harry Collins, Ryan Turnbull and Nelson Foley continued their fine years, while Jordan Doreing showed enough in his first outing, kicking a couple of goals.

Griffith come in off the bye, but had won their last three before that by big margins. Rhys Pollock continues to shine for the Swans, while Nick Conlan, Jack Rowston and Kahlan Spencer have been in good touch.

These two teams played a draw earlier in the year but Griffith appear to have made more progress since. It is the longest road trip in the competition so it won't be easy but expect the Swans to pile on some pressure on the Goannas with a win here.

Prediction: Griffith by 18 points

Wagga Tigers v Turvey Park Bulldogs

What better way to celebrate the rivalry between these two clubs than a high stakes clash at Robertson Oval.

After looking arguably one of the teams to beat a month ago, Wagga Tigers have lost their last three to drop out of the top five. Tigers have been missing some key personnel and desperately need the likes of coach Murray Stephenson, assistant Dyl Morton, Jesse Manton and Shaun Flanigan out on the paddock.

Turvey Park were also missing a number of key personnel for their trip to Kindra Park last Saturday when they dropped just their second game for the year. Antony Forato, Rhett Weidemann, Cal Dooley and Jack Glanvill were among those missing in the loss to Coolamon.

Top spot is now suddenly on the line for the Bulldogs, who have been the most consistent side in the competition up until this point. Another loss here would put the pressure on a relatively young group, while Tigers need the win to stay in touch with the top five.

If Tigers can regain several of their leaders, they are a massive chance but Turvey's consistency has been a highlight to date so you'd expect them to bounce back here.

Prediction: Turvey Park by 8 points

Collingullie-Glenfield Park Demons v Narrandera Eagles

Collingullie-Glenfield Park's season still has a pulse after an impressive win on the road against Mangoplah-Cookardinia United-Eastlakes on Saturday.

The Demons showed what they are capable of with a 20-point win over the Goannas, however they led by more earlier in the contest. Sam Stening kicked eight goals, while the Perryman brothers, Nick, Ed and Joe all had big games. Former star full-forward Marc Geppert now has 18 goals from two games in his comeback in reserve grade so it will be interesting to see if Collingullie pull the trigger on that in coming weeks in what could potentially be a dangerous partnership alongside Stening.

Narrandera were disappointing in their 43-point loss to Leeton-Whitton last weekend. Luke McKay put in another strong performance in the loss while the Eagles will hope to welcome Brad Hutchison back.

The challenge for coach Shaun Brooker is now to keep the playing group motivated and upbeat with six tough games still remaining for the season and the prospect of a win unlikely.

'Griffith strike the perfect recipe'



LIKE any good recipe, Griffith put their rise back up the Riverina League ladder this season down to the perfect blend of talented local juniors combined with some quality, experienced recruits.

Heading into the final seven rounds of the home and away season, Griffith sit in second spot on the first grade ladder, just two points behind Turvey Park in top spot.

It's a big improvement on last year's seventh-placed finish but has not come as any great surprise after a quality recruitment drive over the off-season.

The signing of Queanbeyan quartet Rhys Pollock, Alec McCormick, Alex Page and Dean Simpson, plus the return of club junior Henry Delves from Ainslie, instantly put Griffith's name up in the lights and the Swans were widely tipped as the competition's big improvers for 2023.

But the rise up the ladder hasn't just been on the back of their recruits, with the continued improvement of the club's local base complementing the new arrivals perfectly.

Striking the right balance was a plan executed by the club over the off-season.

"We identified areas that we thought we were weaker in and obviously key position was something and Henry (Delves) popped up and Alec McCormick," Dreyer explained.

"Then obviously the mids, you can never have too many of them because we had a few kids in there and then Rhys Pollock popped up and now he's arguably the best player in the comp I suppose.

"And then Alex Page wanted to play a bit more midfield, he's a small forward and does that role quite well but it allowed us then to move Jack Rowston. The workload on Jack was big, he's really carried us the last couple of years to be fair.

"Then blokes like Kaylan Spencer and Ollie Bartter, they are getting close to 50 games and are playing really well through the midfield as well so it's just given us that depth and ability to share the load a bit more I suppose."

The Queanbeyan connection came about via Sam Daniel, Griffith's assistant coach who used to play at the AFL Canberra club.

It wasn't a case of persistence paying off or anything like that. It was more about the Swans asking the right questions at the right time.

"Probably the right time. Obviously Sam Daniel is there as my assistant and Will Griggs coached us. Jordan Ludica was from there as well so we've had a fair connection (at Queanbeyan) and it was just a conversation," Dreyer said.

"We were on the look and just through Sam and Paul (Rogerson) they were looking to come and play a bit of country footy and they'd spoken to Will and Jordan Ludica and blokes who had played for us in the past. They passed them onto us and we started the conversation.

"They weren't the original four we were talking to but we had a bit of a zoom meeting towards the end of the year, spoke to them about where we were at and just explained what we were like and where we thought we were going and kept in contact and they've been great.

"They've fitted in really well, they're good blokes, they're professional, they're fit and they've just fitted in seamlessly and they're classy players too."

Griffith played off in the 2018 and 2019 grand finals. They didn't take part in the AFL Riverina Championship during the COVID year of 2020 before slipping down the ladder in 2021 and 2022 as part of a rebuilding phase.

Dreyer was due to coach alongside Will Griggs in 2020. He was then named head coach in 2021 and has been at the helm since. He says the playing group's energy never dropped despite harder seasons in 2021 and 2022.

"It's interesting this group, even though we were down those last couple of years and they were so young, they never really dipped in enthusiasm," he said.

"This year, they're getting a few results and this is the hard part of the year but they still turn up and train so there's plenty of excitement. There's not much talk of where we are or anything like that, it's just about getting better, turning up and being consistent.

"I still think we have that dip every now and again although things are better. We've just got more options, we've got a good spread of goals, I think the backline in particular has really started to gel the last couple of weeks. There is always plenty of excitement and the resses are up there too this year."

Dreyer is enjoying being in the driver's seat as Griffith go about trying to end the club's 20-year premierships drought.

"It's been interesting as to how it's evolved and I do, I really enjoy it," Dreyer said.

"Someone asked me the other day about how I'm going with it as well and mentioned how the first time I met Kahlan Spencer and Ollie Barter they were under 13s and they came up and played under 15s with me. Then you've got blokes like Jay Summers, Nicko Conlan then blokes like Taine Moraschi and Pat Payne, they were playing for the (Griffith) White side against me so I've been around them for a long long time and even Jack Rowston I coached in his last year in the juniors so I know what they're like, I know the group.

"Once you know their personality, most of the challenge is confidence and just mindset. You feel like you can have a conversation with the group more so than be barking orders.

"That's the one thing this year that has been really good, because they've now got that confidence, they feel like they belong in the seniors, the training is more of a conversation. We're playing such and such and we've got to do this and we've got to work on that.

"It's a real good team atmosphere at the moment, which is the pleasing thing.

"I certainly enjoy it, it's a big job, coaching the seniors, but it's nice to have that connection with them for so long and I'm looking forward to the rest of the year."


