# RFNL PREVIEW



## Griffith Swans v Wagga Tigers

The biggest game of a huge final round of the Riverina League takes place at Exies Oval between Griffith and Wagga Tigers.

Tigers need to conquer the road trip and get themselves the four points to cement their finals spot. If not, they open the door to lose their spot to Collingullie-Glenfield Park on percentage. Tigers are playing pretty well and have won four of their last five. They would have liked to have been a little more accurate in front of goal last week, kicking 14.21 in their 68-point win over Narrandera. That has probably kept the door open a little more ajar for the Demons.

Like most of the top six teams, there's no doubt that Tigers' best is good enough to go all the way so should they make finals, they will be a threat. Murray Stephenson will return for the big game, but Tigers will most likely be without Jeremy Piercy due to a hamstring injury.

Griffith will be desperate to turn their form around before finals after losing three out of the past four. Collingullie-Glenfield Park put them away by 30 points last week and now their top-three spot and a double chance are on the line. Also if they lose this, they face the probability of having to back up and reverse the result against Tigers in a sudden-death final at a neutral venue a week later.

## Mangoplah-Cookardinia United-Eastlakes Goannas v Coolamon Rovers

It shapes as a nervy final-round trip out to Mangoplah for Coolamon, who could mathematically still miss finals if they fail to get the job done.

The Rovers fell 38 points short of Ganmain-Grong Grong-Matong in the local derby last week, making it back-to-back losses at the wrong time of year. The bright note is, a win can potentially put them to third and provide a double chance. A loss, and if results went the wrong way, could see them miss out on the top five altogether.

Coolamon need more from key forward Tim Oosterhoff. He's had a good year, kicking 53 goals but only once has he kicked more than four against a top five opponent. Joe Redfern returned to provide good support last week, and along with the likes of Jerry Maslin, Jeremy Sykes and the Mattingly boys, there's still enough potency to be providing headaches for opposition teams.

Mangoplah-Cookardinia United-Eastlakes will turn up with nothing to lose and will get a free swing at the Rovers. There's no doubt the Goannas playing group will want to send outgoing coach Jeremy Rowe out on a winning note and what better opportunity than to throw a potential spanner in the works of the finals make-up.

It will be interesting to see how they shape up after they threw things around with success last week against Leeton-Whitton. Either way, they'll be playing with freedom, which can be dangerous.

It's been another disappointing season from Narrandera, who will finish with the wooden spoon after failing to win a game up until this point. It's been a step backwards after winning four games last year and then recruiting reasonably well over the off-season. Luke McKay has been a shining light and will no doubt lead the way for the Eagles again, while Brad Hutchuson will also be looking for a big finish to the year.

# 'Volunteer power transforms the Kindra colosseum'



THEY say that many hands make light work and that couldn't be more appropriate when it comes to the transformation of Kindra Park into one of the Riverina's premier sporting facilities.

A little over four years ago, Coolamon Rovers Football Netball Club developed an eight-stage master plan to upgrade the Kindra Park precinct.

The club had already recently upgraded its canteen facilities, the Kindra Park 1 irrigation system, extended the main ground, installed a new scoreboard, relaid the netball courts and constructed new seating throughout.

But the Kindra Park Trust, with Coolamon Rovers as the major tenant, were not about to stop there.

The eight stage-master plan has already seen the completion of new lighting for Kindra Park 1 and 2 and widening of Kindra Park 2.

A new irrigation system for Kindra Park 2, new toilets and change rooms, unisex change rooms and upgrades to netball facilities have been funded and are in progress.

Traffic safety and hospitality facility improvements are next, as well as an upgrade to the power supply.

The motivation behind the master plan is to increase participation in sport and recreation, the safety for participants and supporters, and inclusiveness.

"To increase participation, we needed to provide a facility that is not only modern, but also encourages volunteers to engage with the club through improved facilities. It needs to be good for players and good for supporters equally so," club secretary Scott Glyde, a driving force behind the master plan, said.

"To ensure safety, we needed to make sure that the facilities provided a safe environment to perform in but also make the precinct safe to visit.

"To maximise inclusiveness, we needed to better cater for unisex football programs, and female players as well as female umpires. We also needed to provide facilities that did not disadvantage young families, or parents with infants or toddlers. And we also needed to provide better facilities for disabled persons to attend events as well, to ensure they did not feel disadvantaged in coming to the Kindra Park to watch sporting events.

"Additionally, the benefit of these works was not just aimed at supporting football netball participation, but also summer pursuits such as touch football and cricket, thereby drawing in wider community members, not just those that play football and netball.

"All of these things are collectively focused on providing a 'whole-of-family' and 'whole of year' benefit to members of the community."

And community is what it's all about at Coolamon.

Those involved in the management of the facility take pride in the fact that Kindra Park is not council land, nor does it receive any contribution from council towards upkeep, maintenance or improvement.

It's powered by the hard work of volunteers.

"One thing we're pretty proud of as a footy club...is that anything you see out there is purely done by volunteers at the footy club," club treasurer Ryan Batholomew said.

"There is no contribution from council at all. That's something that we're pretty proud of, which we think builds really good connectivity within our club, because we need more people.

"Whilst it's more work, we see it as a real asset for our club and we have a great band of volunteers that chip in, they band together and they're really proud of what they do.

"What it also encourages is real buy-in from the community as well and we're trying to communicate that to the broader community because Coolamon is growing, there are a lot of people coming to town and they're getting to know how it rolls out here. It's a pretty good, clean, connected community and when you get more people that understand how things run out here, particularly from our footy club's point of view and our precinct that we all chip in and do it together, it not only contributes to the ongoing success of the footy club that we have on-field, we'd like a bit more on-field that we're working towards, but it builds real connection within the town and businesses as well.

"We've got some fantastic sponsors that support us, support the facility and a lot of in-kind sponsorship that we basically rely on to keep going because we can spend upwards of \$20,000 to \$30,000 a year on maintenance on our precinct and we've got to raise that within our footy club."

Countless hours of manual labour and project design-management is provided free of charge by many members, including players and sponsors.

D&L Laser - Duncan and Leonie McCallum Earthmoving - in particular, is a major provider of heavily discounted or free support each and every year via its earthmoving equipment.

The voluntary contribution of local businesses like Regal Signs and Coolamon Plumbing is also highly valued by the club as well. Beyond that, long term sponsors like Coolamon Chaser Bins, Steel Supplies and Allens Coaches especially, support a stable operating environment for the club to confidently plan for the continuous improvement of the precinct for the next generation.

Club president Bryan Buchanan is extremely proud of the transformation.

"From when I played, in particular, it's chalk and cheese. It's almost unrecognisable really," Buchanan said.

"As club president, I'm extremely proud of all the hard work that goes into achieving what we've achieved, to firstly get the grants that we've got and how much work that involved from Scott (Glyde), he's been the driving force behind the grants, and then the lighting, the surface of the ground, the coaches boxes, the scoreboard, that's what we've got so far and then what we're planning on for the future is unisex changerooms and there's more things to do for netball that are going to be coming.

"It's just a great facility for our town and our community and it's important that people know that it is volunteer work that does it. It surprises a lot of people."

One thing an upgraded Kindra Park has provided is the opportunity to continue to push same-day senior and junior football and netball. It is one initiative that the club has always and continues to be a big supporter of.

"The CRFNC is 'One Club'. There is no junior club or senior club. We are one whole club," Glyde said.

"And that means everything we plan, everything we invest in or seek funding for, targets benefits for families and all players, from the Net Set Go and AusKick players upwards that become our senior players of the future.

"This is why CRFNC promotes and enjoys 'same-day' senior junior days. It brings everyone together, allows families with older and younger members to be in the same place at the same time, provides opportunities for the young players to watch the senior players they so admire and allows us to not only play together, but socialise together afterwards."

The Kindra Park precinct is a big commitment for Coolamon but as they put it, they wouldn't have it any other way.

"It's hard work, unfortunately it is and it's not easy to get funding but fortunately we've got some people in our footy club that are just willing to do it at no cost," Bartholomew said.

"Once again, volunteers, we've created that culture I guess and I think it's come off the back of it being a voluntary facility, not a council-run facility, where we've got to buy the paint to mark the lines, we've got to buy our own line-marker, we've got to buy our own mower, we've got to put our own fuel in the mowers, we've got to find someone to do it.

"It's a substantial cost that we have to create and absorb every year as part of our revenue in our footy club but something we wouldn't shy away from, we wouldn't want it any other way."


